ORDINANCE NO. 2023-017

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 133 ARTICLE XXIII OF THE
 TRAFFIC AND PARKING MANAGEMENT CODE OF CAINTA, RIZAL**

WHEREAS, on February 29, 2016, the Sangguniang Bayan of Cainta enacted Ordinance No. 2016-007 – An Ordinance Enacting the Traffic and Parking Management Code of Cainta, Rizal;

WHEREAS, subject Ordinance provides for the traffic rules and regulations on all roads in the municipality, whether national or local in classification, pedestrian rules and regulations, the use of sidewalks and alleys, road use by all motor vehicles and other forms of conveyances, whether public or private, day-parking zones and night Parking zones, and in general, such other rules and regulations hereinafter promulgated in furtherance of an optimum utilization of the road network in the municipality;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AS IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN IN A SESSION DULY ASSEMBLED THAT:

Section 1. Amendment. Section 133, Article XXIII of the Traffic and Parking Management Code of Cainta, Rizal is hereby amended by incorporating a ten-minute provision.

Authorized towing contractors shall give at least 10-minutes leeway before towing-away any illegally parked or stalled vehicles due to accident or broken-down vehicles within the territorial jurisdiction of Cainta, Rizal.


Section 2. Separability Clause. If for any reason, any section or provision of this Ordinance is declared illegal or unconstitutional other sections or provisions hereto which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Section 3. Repealing Clause. All previous issuances, Ordinances, rules and regulations or parts thereof which are inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.





Section 4. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval.




